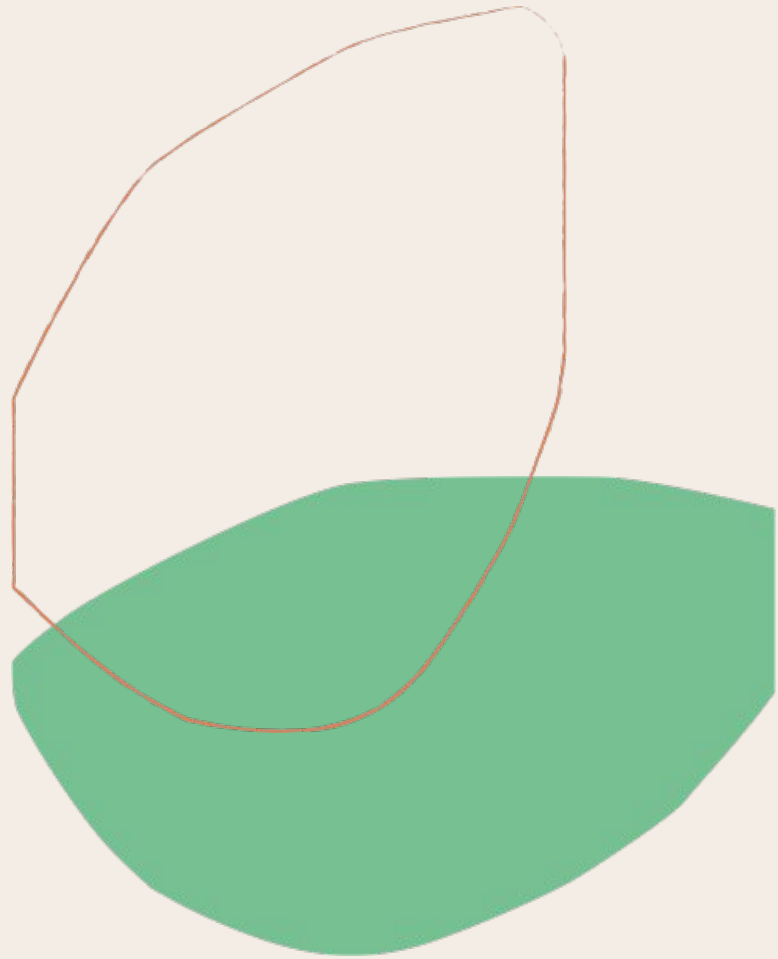

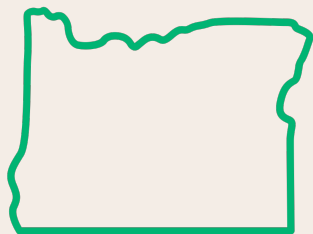
Our Mission

Eligibility



Be based in Oregon



**Have 501(c)(3) tax
exemption or a 501(c)(3)
fiscal sponsor***

Priorities

We prioritize funding small, emerging, and grassroots organizations that:

- address root causes**
- build collective power**
- are intentionally anti-racist, anti-oppression, and intersectional**
- are led by the people most impacted**



Spring 2023 Funding Overview

With a **\$400,000*** budget for this Spring

- Funding for up to **30 applications**
- Range of **\$7,000 to \$15,000**



Operating Support Grants

- For **501(c)(3) organizations only**
- Annual budget of **\$700,000 or less**
- Max amount **\$15,000**



Project Support Grants

- **501(c)(3)** organizations with **budget over \$700,000**; or
- **Fiscally sponsored** organizations
- Max amount **\$15,000**
- For **non-incorporated organizations** that engage in “charitable activities”
- Max amount **\$7,000**

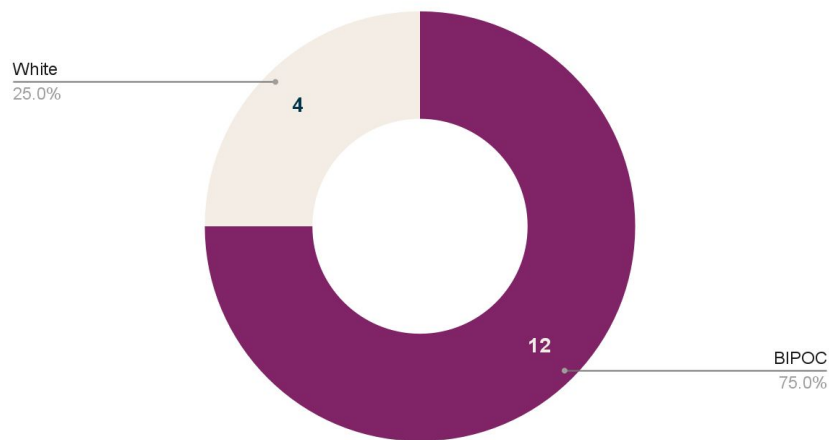

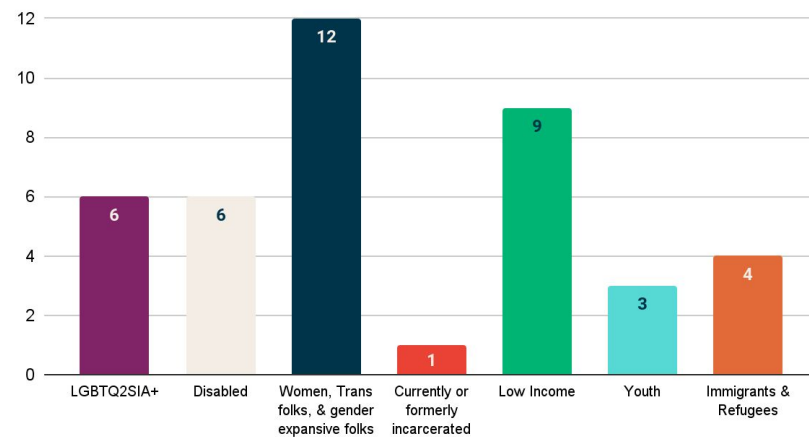

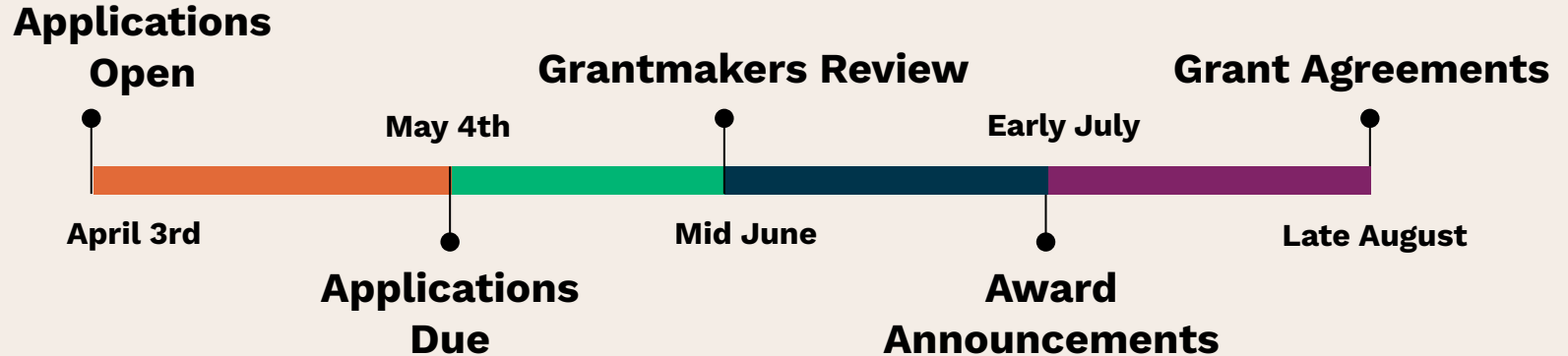
