
Our Mission

Have 501(c)(3) tax exemption or a 501(c)(3) fiscal sponsor*

Priorities

We prioritize funding small, emerging, and grassroots organizations that:

- → address root causes
- → build collective power
- → are intentionally anti-racist, anti-oppression, and intersectional
- → are led by the people most impacted

Spring 2023 Funding Overview

With a **\$400,000* budget** for this Spring

→ Funding for up to 30 applications
→ Range of \$7,000 to \$15,000

Operating Support Grants

- → For 501(c)(3) organizations only
- → Annual budget of \$700,000 or less
- → Max amount **\$15,000**


Project Support Grants

- → 501(c)(3)
 organizations with
 budget over
 \$700,000; or
 → Fiscally sponsored
 - organizations
- → Max amount **\$15,000**

- → For non-incorporated organizations that engage in "charitable activities"
- → Max amount **\$7,000**

Grantee Budgets








